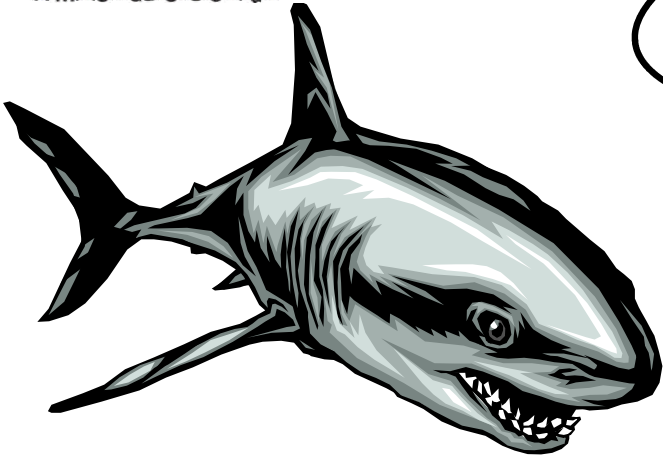

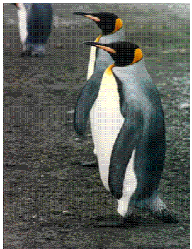

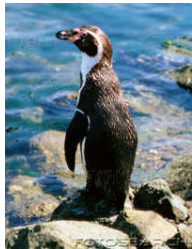
There are 17 different species of penguins and they all live south of the Equator!
