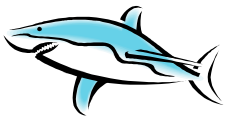

Identify each animal as egg-laying, live-bearing or neither.



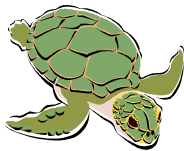

Draw a line from each animal to all of its food sources!

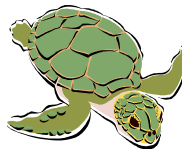


Animals without backbones are called **invertebrates**. Animals with backbones are called **vertebrates**!
